

CR-2 EXPECTATIONS FOR CONGREGATION COUNCIL MEMBERS

In accordance with the constitution, the members of the Congregation Council are expected to fulfill the following.

The Congregation Council shall have general oversight of the life and activities of this congregation, and in particular its worship life, to the end that everything be done in accordance with the Word of God and the faith and practice of the ELCA.

Be a voting member of St. John's and maintain that status throughout the term of office by communing and making a recorded contribution each year.

- Attend regularly scheduled meetings.
- Do the utmost to complete the term for which elected
- Lead the congregation in stating its mission, do long-range planning; set goals and priorities, and evaluate activities in light of the mission and goals.
- Seek to involve all members of St. John's in worship, learning, witness, service and support
- Oversee and provide for the administration of St. John's to enable it to fulfill its functions and perform its mission.
- Maintain supportive relationships with the pastors and staff.
- Be examples individually and as a Congregation Council of the style of life and ministry expected of all baptized persons.
- Promote a congregational climate of peace and goodwill and, as differences arise, endeavor to foster mutual understanding.
- Provide supervision for annual review of the membership roster.
- Perform role of liaison to a Ministry Team.
- Be responsible for the financial and property matters of St. John's.
- Carry out the provisions of St. John's Constitution, Bylaws and Continuing Resolutions.
- Willingly accept other duties as may be required.
