Lutheran World Relief Ingathering

We welcomed 82 different churches to St. John's and packed 1,723 boxes containing 5,548 quilts; 580 baby care kits; 3,933 school kits; and 3,161 personal care kits. A grand total of \$15,379 was given to help with shipping costs. **St. John's totals:** 273 quilts; 630 school kits; 627 personal care kits; \$2,000 donated; and more than 50 people volunteered at the Ingathering.
