You will be asked to turn off and put away your cell phones.</li> </ul> <p><b>*** Packing Recommendations ***</b> (Pack a larger duffle bag with all of your gear. This will be placed under the bus for the entire trip. You will NOT have access to this bag until we are at our destination.)</p> <p>Bring a carry on bag which will include your <b>Work Camp T Shirt</b>. We will be wearing that shirt at the opening ceremonies and possibly when we arrive at Bolivar, Tennessee.</p> <p>Please do NOT use your cell phones on the bus during our trips. No music on the bus either – we will use this time to visit with each other and for prayer and fellowship.</p>
