this church. But this year, the election was peaceful and transparent. Senior Pastor Geoffrey Njapau was re-elected for a second term. Rev. Christopher Manianga was elected Vice-Senior Pastor. ELCZa will have a new General Secretary, Rev. Godfrey Nguvulu, and a new Treasurer, Mrs. Mbutolwe Kamendu. A finance committee chair was also elected for the first time.

At the close of the Assembly, we witnessed the ordination of 12 new pastors.

These new pastors previously served as evangelists, where they led congregations under the supervision of a district pastor. The new pastors only have one year of theological education, so I am looking at ways continue their to pastoral formation.
